Another Visit to RVMC



MEDFORD, OR - After CCW's General Manager, Joey Sanders, spending most of the month of June in and out of the hospital after a severe infection that went septic caused a bout of cellulitis in the lower half of his right leg, Friday, August 1st, CCW President and CEO, Brunella M. Falgout was rushed to the E.R. with abdominal pain. After several batteries of tests, doctors determined that Ms. Falgout had appendicitis, and removed her appendix early the next morning.

Brunella is recovering nicely at home. She spent her time at Rogue Valley Medical Center on the same floor, but the opposite side of the wing that Joey spent a majority of his time outside the ICU while there. Brunella should be back to 100% by the end of August.

Joey's recovery is slowly but surely progressing as well. His leg is now down to just a small handful of small wounds that still need attention, and has lost close to 40 pounds since his ordeal started on June 5th. He will be undergoing compression therapy for the next 6 to 8 weeks, but has been cleared to start a light to moderate exercise regiment as long as he doesn't push too hard. Joey has decided to get back to basics with both timed walking, and combat conditioning exercises to help get the flexibility back into his lower body.
